A NOTE FROM PASTOR STEPHANIE:

Live, Laugh, Love

A few weeks ago I was invited to a gathering at one of our church family's homes. As I walked into their living room, my eyes immediately noticed a sign high above the window that stated, "Live, Laugh, Love!" I have a plaque with those words on it in my house, but this wasn't a plaque – the entire family had helped paint it right on the living room wall – it was in big lettering and I discovered it had been there for many years.

As I looked at these 3 simple words etched across about 9 feet of the living room wall with art work from all their kids, a scripture came to mind from Deuteronomy 6:4-9: "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates."

The more I looked at those words, and thought about the people who inhabited that house, I discovered something... they really practice what the sign said. They have a wonderful life together. They travel. They play and they do so many things that if you get a chance to talk to them in private you will come to the conclusion that in that home there is LIFE. In that home there is not a single dull moment. There is always laughter and joy. It feels like it is Christmas year around. The love I got to feel in that particular home had meaning and purpose. Something funny happened, I wanted to stay there. I was one of the last people to leave the gathering. I felt something different, something transforming, and something divine.

As we go through the many ups and downs of our lives we are confronted with our humanity. We have doubts and fears and heartache's and struggles. I think when those difficult times in our lives arise, we need to think of these three simple words, LIVE, LAUGH, LOVE. These words can be reminders to us of what Christianity is all about – to live, to laugh, and to love. As a church, those words are our motto, they are our Gospel, and they are our hope!

So, let's remind ourselves to live, laugh, and love even if we have to write it on our walls or windows. Let's remind ourselves that God calls us to live abundantly, laugh until everyone can hear us, and love like there's no tomorrow! For when we do, we change ourselves for the greater good and inspire others to find the best within themselves. Put these three words somewhere in your home, and may God give you the good fortune to live




2011-2012 CONFIRMATION NEWS
